

CTEP PREPARATION PROGRAM

Prepare for the **College Test for English Placement (CTEP)**
at SCE's Learning Centers

The CTEP is an assessment designed to measure the English skills of native English speakers. If the college you plan to transfer to requires you to take the CTEP, take advantage of this program to improve your English assessment scores and place into a higher level college English course. The CTEP may not be used for placement into English as a second language courses. Practice CTEP tests are available at all three SCE Learning Centers.

Benefits of scoring higher on the CTEP:

Save money and time! You will have fewer courses to take if you are placed into an English 100 class. You do not receive college general education English credit until you take a 100 level class.
